

Directions to Greenbank Sports Academy

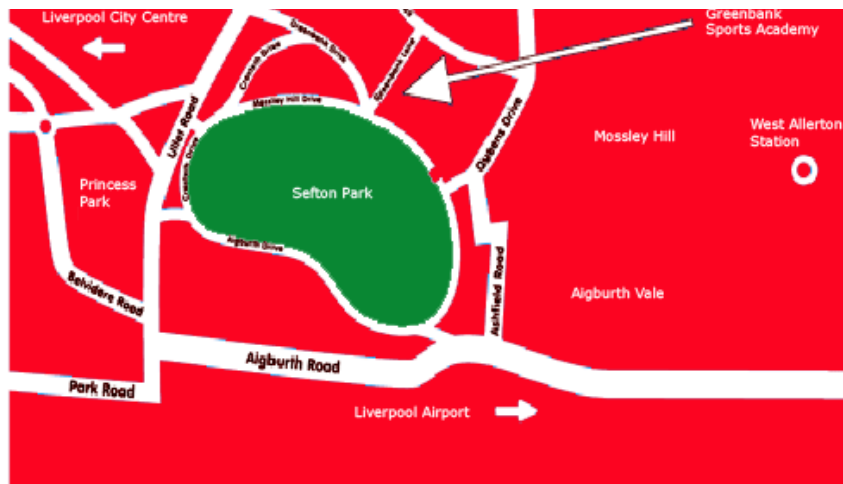
From the end of the M62 (Junction 4) take the extreme left hand lane (before the fly-over) that joins the A5058 (Queens Drive). Continue straight on at the lights to a roundabout. Take the 3rd exit and continue to a set of lights – straight on. Move to the right hand lane (marked Queens Drive and City Centre) before another roundabout and travel straight on (2nd lane from the left) through the lights (road marked Queens Drive). Continue through a set of pedestrian lights, under a railway bridge to another set of lights. Turn right into Mossley Hill Road (North), which becomes Greenbank Road. Continue straight on, passing Penny Lane to the right. Greenbank Lane follows shortly on the left hand side. The entrance to Greenbank Sports Academy is situated about

The wheelchair user sections may be joined together if there are not enough entries to have two sections. There will also be a junior category in any section if there are sufficient entries to warrant it.

Players should wear suitable footwear for an indoor tournament i.e. trainers that will not mark the floor and provide their own bat.

Shields will be awarded to the winners of each section and medals will be awarded to the runners up in each section.
