



Tameside Overview

Since the first Active Lives release, November 2015-16, Tameside has seen a decrease in inactivity levels across the majority of cohorts. The exceptions to this are those aged 16-34 and middle income categories. The largest decreases in inactivity have been amongst those aged 55-74 with a 10.6% decrease, those with a long term limiting disability, a 7.1% decrease, and those aged 75+, a 7.0% decrease.
